**WEDDING ARRANGEMENTS:** We love weddings and think Onguma is the ideal location for a spectacular bush wedding. Special drink stops and bush events can be arranged for an additional fee. Similarly, flowers, sound equipment, lights and décor items will also need to be hired at an additional fee. Please note that we can only have a wedding in a camp if you book out the whole camp.

**RATE BASIS:** Fully Inclusive (FI) – includes accommodation, Breakfast, Lunch, High Tea, Dinner (4-course), Beverages – Bar and Mini Bar (beers, local spirits, soft drinks, water and house wines), Etosha Morning Drive and Onguma Sundowner Drive (on Onguma Reserve). Transfer from and to the Onguma airstrip, VAT, Hai//om levy and NTB tourism levy.

Most rate packages are quoted on a Dinner, Bed and Breakfast basis, and lunch can be provided. We offer breakfast and lunch packs and will happily arrange these if you will be out exploring the Park during the day. All extra meals at an additional fee.


**LOCATION:** Onguma Nature Reserve consists of 34 000 ha of magnificent Namibian wilderness, adjacent to the world famous Etosha National Park.

**ACCESS:** Coming from the south, follow the B1 direction North/ Etosha, turn left onto the C38 and you will reach Onguma's entrance on the right-hand side after 25 km, just before Etosha's Namutoni entrance gate. Then follow the signs to your lodge. Each lodge is between 10 to 20 minutes on good dirt roads.

Coming from the west you will leave Etosha at the von Lindequist Gate, Namutoni. You immediately turn left at the entrance to Onguma Nature Reserve. Each lodge is between 10 to 20 minutes on good dirt roads; follow the signs to your lodge.

**ACTIVITIES:** Onguma offers a variety of activities, including guided game safaris in Etosha National Park. On Onguma Nature Reserve, activities include guided interpretive bush walks, the Onkolo photographic hide, sunset nature drives, Onguma crafted massages and the Dream Cruiser sleep-out experience.

**GAME VIEWING:** Onguma Nature Reserve boasts more than thirty different animal species, including plains game such as giraffe, kudu, oryx, eland, hartebeest, zebra, impala and black rhino, as well as predators such as lion, cheetah and leopard. In addition, more than 300 bird species that can be seen on the reserve.



During the Namibian summer months, Onguma becomes a bird-watcher's paradise with thousands of birds migrating to the wetlands created by the seasonal rains and ephemeral river systems.

**ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** We request that you check out by 10.00am to allow us to prepare the room for new arrivals. Arrival time is from 1.00pm onwards. Should you need a late check out, please arrange with the lodge and this will be accommodated if possible.

**CHILDREN:** Onguma Bush Camp is best suited for accommodating children as it fenced and has great family and loft rooms. The Young Explorer's Walk is a fun, guided educational activity, the open pool area ensures safe play and sprawling lawns provide ample space to run around and expend excess energy.

## ACCOMMODATION

Onguma Nature Reserve offers visitors five unique lodges and two well-equipped campsites.

### ONGUMA CAMP KALA

#### 4 Suites elevated on wooden decks

With its central tower resembling a termite hill and the whole camp elevated on wooden decks, Onguma Camp Kala sets a new benchmark for luxury whilst offering panoramic views over the floodlit waterhole below. The thatched camp is centered around game viewing with numerous vantage points to take it all in – be it the comfortable lounge, the intimate cocktail bar or the beautiful deck - which is sunny by day and warmed by a fire pit at night. The dining area has an open plan “show” kitchen and all-day pantry to ensure everyone feels right at home. Below deck, guests can while away the hours in absolute comfort in the air-conditioned water-level photographic hide. Other facilities include a fully equipped gym and massage treatment room.

It doesn't get more exclusive – linked with raised walkways, there are just four Suites. All have beautiful bathrooms with double vanities, full-size bathtubs, separate indoor and outdoor showers and private toilets. Outdoors, each Suite has its own private deck with



wood-fired hot tub, loungers, seating area with fire pit, and private sala (gazebo) with daybed.

### ONGUMA THE FORT

#### 11 Bush Suites (48.5 m<sup>2</sup> + outside deck 60.5 m<sup>2</sup>), 1 Sultan Suite (78.5 m<sup>2</sup> + outside deck 21 m<sup>2</sup>) & 1 Honeymoon Suite (69.25 m<sup>2</sup> + outside deck 44 m<sup>2</sup>)

With dramatic Moroccan details and only one of its' kind, Onguma The Fort offers something new to discover around every corner, and has probably one of the best sunset views in Namibia.

Overlooking the vast Fischer's Pan in Etosha, the main guest areas of the lodge consist of a lounge, two dining areas, an art gallery, safari boutique, swimming pool, sundowner pool with bar, massage room, tower viewing area and a large deck with uninterrupted views.

Accommodation consists of eleven Bush Suites, a Sultan Suite and one Honeymoon Suite. All Suites are equipped with outdoor shower, yoga mats, air-conditioning and Etosha sandstone fire-places for the winter months. The Sultan Suite is on the upper level of the main complex and includes a lounge, flat screen television, bath, shower and a private viewing deck. The Honeymoon Suite



is completely private and offers a lounge, flat screen television, a wood-fired hot-tub, outdoor bath and shower with views that will enchant.

### ONGUMA TENTED CAMP

#### 7 Luxury Tents

Reminiscent of that 'Out of Africa' under canvas romance, Onguma Tented Camp is built in the treeline around an active waterhole. The main guest area includes a spacious reception area, small safari shop, dining area, two comfortable lounges, rim flow swimming pool, large deck and an open fire pit.

Extending around the waterhole in a u-shape design are seven spacious tents, constructed from Etosha stone and triple-layered canvas tents on decks. Interiors are spacious with air-conditioning over the bed, an indoor and outdoor shower, a modern interpretation of an over-sized old zinc bath, separate toilet, two stone basins and a sitting area with uninterrupted views of the waterhole.

You don't even have to leave the camp as you can enjoy watching nature at play around the clock from the comfort of the lounge and dining areas that overlook the large waterhole.

The large swimming pool and gardens are perfect for children to enjoy the open spaces. In the afternoon they can take part in a Young Explorer's Walk with a professional guide, whilst mom and dad enjoy one of our famous Onguma-crafted massages.

## ONGUMA ETOSHA AOA

11 Rooms consisting of 4 Heritage Bungalows, 3 Bush Suites, 3 Explorer Bungalows, 1 Honeymoon Bungalow

Tucked into the trees is Onguma Etosha Aoba, an intimate and relaxed bush lodge with a taste of yesteryear safari-style. An impressive wine cellar complements delicious meals served under the stars, whilst the large waterhole ensures there is game activity to catch your eye, even while sipping a drink in the pool.

Blending into the surrounds, offering a mixture of comfort and privacy the bungalows feature thatched roofs, wooden furniture and private verandas to enjoy views of the Namibian bush. The lodge consists of 4 free-standing Heritage Bungalows, 3 Bush Suites that each have two rooms with an inter-leading bathroom, 3 free-standing Explorer Bungalows, and a secluded Honeymoon Bungalow with a double hammock in the trees and a romantic outside shower and bath! The down-to-earth friendly character of the lodge and staff ensures you will return.

Luxury camping at its best! Private sites, private shower room and separate toilets as well as ample washing-up space. Plugs ensure cameras and computers are always charged, with free Wi-Fi available in the bar and at the swimming pool. And if you don't feel like making a fire – enjoy a hearty meal at the restaurant overlooking the waterhole. The campsite is serviced daily, assuring you a hassle-free stay. Guests are not allowed to take their own vehicles onto the 34 000 hectare Onguma Nature Reserve, but game-drives, sunset nature drives, interactive walks, Onkolo Hide and the Dream Cruiser sleep-out experience can all be booked at reception.

### LEADWOOD CAMPSITE

Camping under shady Leadwood trees, surrounded by bush, yet in close proximity to Onguma Bush Camp where you can enjoy the lodge facilities. Leadwood offers the best of both worlds and ideal for the Etosha camper. Each campsite has been thoughtfully positioned and has its own shower, toilet and power point. The campsite is serviced on a daily basis assuring you a hassle-free stay. Book all six sites and have this charming campsite to yourself.
