ACCOMMODATION AND FACILITIES:

With its central tower resembling a termite hill and the whole camp elevated on wooden decks, Onguma Camp Kala sets a new benchmark for luxury whilst offering panoramic views over the floodlit waterhole below. The thatched camp is centered around game viewing with numerous vantage points to take it all in, be it the comfortable lounge, the intimate cocktail bar or the beautiful deck - which is sunny by day and warmed by a fire pit at night. The dining area has an open plan “show” kitchen and all-day pantry to ensure everyone feels right at home. Below the deck, guests can while away the hours in absolute comfort in the air-conditioned photographic hide. Other facilities include a fully equipped gym, yoga deck and spa.

Complete with butler service, it does not get more exclusive – linked by raised walkways, there are just four Suites. Spacious and private, the Suites have sumptuous twin/king beds and indoor lounges with full mini bar and tea/coffee making facilities, with beautiful bathrooms featuring double vanities, full-size free-standing bathtub, separate indoor shower, and private toilet. Outdoors, each Suite has its own private deck with wood-fired hot tub, plunge pool, loungers, seating area and private Sala (gazebo) with king-size daybed. Free Wi-Fi is available throughout. No children under 12 are allowed unless the entire property is reserved for exclusive use. When booked for exclusive use the camp can accommodate up to 8 adults and 2 children rather than the usual 8 guests.

CHILD POLICY:

- Where applicable, Children under 3 years stay for free, and Children from 3 to 11 years sharing with adults pay the listed child rate.
- The above-mentioned rate for children is a nett rate and includes specified meals.
- Children 12 years and above will be accommodated in their own room at the adult rate.
- Four of the "Big Five" (lion, leopard, rhino and elephant) roam free on the Onguma Nature Reserve Onguma Camp Kala, Onguma The Fort, Onguma Tented Camp, and are not fenced and children should therefore be under constant adult supervision.
- Onguma Camp Kala, The Fort and Tented Camps cannot accommodate a 3rd bed.
- Game Drives are conducted on open safari vehicles. Children under 7 years are not permitted on game drive vehicles. The exception is only if a private game drives is booked; private game drives are an extra cost, are subject to availability and should be booked in advance.
- Children under the age of 16 years are not permitted on walking safaris or Hide activities.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT LEVY

- The Social Development Fund was formed in 2017 as successor to the Haii//om Bushmen Development Trust. The Social Development Fund aims to uplift all communities surrounding the Onguma Nature Reserve through education and small business development.
- As from 1 November 2017 the N\$10 levy is included in the rate, and this levy is not Vat-able.

CONSERVATION LEVY

- The Conservation Levy is compulsory and is utilized to guard and protect the Rhino and other animals on Onguma Nature Reserve.
- N\$ 275.00 per bed night (per person per night) will be applicable to all lodge-based bed nights, including children and guides.
- N\$ 65.00 per bed night (per person per night) will be applicable to all campsite-based bed nights, including children and guides.
- This levy is Vat-able.

AIRFIELD TRANSFERS:

- Please advise the booking office estimated arrival and departure times if guests are flying in to Mokuti or Onguma airstrip. Kindly make sure you specify at which airstrip.
- Onguma Airstrip - no landing, parking or pick up fees are charged and transfer is included for all Onguma lodges.
- Landing and parking fees at Mokuti Airstrip are for the clients account and should be paid on arrival at Mokuti Lodge.
- A fee of N\$ 1,800.00 will be charged per vehicle for return transfers from Mokuti Airstrip for any additional trips that needs to be made. Guest transfer for arrival and departure are included and not charged for.

CHECK IN / OUT POLICY:

Check-in time is from 14h00 and check out time is 10h00 for the convenience of the arriving guests. Earlier check in time, if requested, will be considered subject to availability of rooms. In all instances expected time of arrival must be advised.

GENERAL BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- All bookings, amendments and cancellations must be made to us in writing and will only be valid once we confirm back in writing.
- STO rates are only valid if a registered agent/tour operator does the booking and payment.
- Provisional bookings will be held for 14 days and will be automatically released where no written confirmation is received.
- Provisional bookings made within the cancellation period will be held for a period of 24 hours and will be automatically released where no written confirmation is received.
- Although every effort is made to keep rates unchanged during the year, all rates and conditions are subject to change.
- Single Supplements will be charged per night when booking 3 night packages.

CANCELLATION POLICY (BOOKINGS OF MAX 3 ROOMS):

In the event of a confirmed booking not being cancelled or amended in writing, the following cancellation policy will apply:

CAMPSITE CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event of a confirmed reservation being cancelled and not postponed (in writing) 100% cancellation fees will be charged and pre-payments will be non-refundable.

GROUP BOOKING PROCEDURE

- Bookings of more than 3 rooms (including guide room) will be viewed as a group booking.
- Group bookings of 3 rooms or more, need to be cancelled 91 days before travel.
- Should the lodge receive a confirmed booking the lodge will notify the relevant block / group booking company and the company will have 48 hours to either confirm the room at our block / group booking cancellation policy or release the room back to us for sale.
- Block / group bookings must be confirmed with a rooming list, stating guests' full names, at the latest 90 days before the travel date, at which time the 25% non-refundable administration deposit is due.

- A group booking is only guaranteed once a 25% non-refundable administration deposit has been paid. We will endeavour to hold the rooms for you as long as possible but, only a deposit guarantees the booking.
- To secure a booking, a deposit can be paid at any time prior to 90 days.
- Any room/s not confirmed and paid for (deposit) 90 days before travel will be automatically released and can be booked subject to availability at a later stage on a first come first serve basis.

GROUP BOOKING CANCELLATION POLICY:

- Bookings of 3 or more rooms (including guide room) will be viewed as a group booking.
 - 25% Cancellation Fees apply to all confirmed bookings, which are cancelled before 90 days prior to arrival.
 - If a group booking or part thereof is cancelled between 30 – 90 days prior to arrival, a 25% cancellation fee on the entire booking will be levied.
 - If a group booking or part thereof is cancelled within 30 days a 50% cancellation fee will be levied as a 30-day release period (or less) makes it quite impossible to fill our beds.
