

# YOUNG EXPLORERS WALK

## *the secrets of the bush*

**D**esigned for our youngest bush explorers, this fun and interactive experience inspires curiosity, learning and adventure. The gentle walk meanders through the natural bush within the fenced grounds of Onguma Bush Camp, providing a safe and engaging environment to discover the wonders of the African bush. Along the way, young adventurers can examine animal skulls and horns, investigate termite mounds, test their balancing skills, practise target shooting with *ketties* (the local name for a slingshot) and bows and arrows, identify animal spoor, learn about traditional hunting techniques, and discover the fascinating trees and plants found along the trail. This adventure concludes with a craft activity, where each child creates a special souvenir to take home.



### ACTIVITY

- Departure: The walk departs from Onguma Bush Camp reception area. Please check with reception for the current departure time as it varies according to the season.
- On this interactive activity, children are accompanied by one of our experienced guides.
- The guide begins each walk with a short, introductory briefing and each young explorer is given an activity backpack.
- Learn about animal spoor, skulls, horns, trees and indigenous plants through fun, hands-on activities.
- Duration approximately 1–2 hours.
- Suggested clothing: We recommend closed walking shoes and a hat or cap. Please apply sunscreen before the walk starts.

- Minimum 2 children
- Age group: 5–12 years old
- Water, a snack and a packed activity bag are provided
